## **OUR PROGRAM**

1. End the war on Black and Brown people. Reparations now. Stand with and defend the Black Lives Matter Movement.
2. End racism. Support self-determination for Black, Latinx, Indigenous, Asian and Arab peoples.
3. Abolish capitalism.
4. Stop the deportations and raids. Full rights for all migrants. End Islamophobia. Open the borders for people; close the borders for profiteers and warmongers. No human being is illegal!
5. Food, water, housing, clothing, health care, education and childcare for all. Solidarity with homeless people. Moratorium NOW! to stop all foreclosures, evictions, utility shut-offs. Justice for the people of Flint, Mich. Free education for all, full funding for public schools. Job training with a stipend. Cancel student debt. Defend the right of student athletes to strike for a living wage.
6. Women need full liberation in all facets of society. Equal pay for comparable work. Reproductive justice, including the right to abortion. Restore all welfare programs. Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer liberation now. Stop the murders of trans women. Full rights for all queer people.
7. Change the system, not the climate. Make the Pentagon and oil corporations pay for the destruction of the planet. Reparations for climate victims of Hurricane Katrina and elsewhere. Immediate support for climate refugees. Free the land! Justice For Berta Cáceres! Free Palestine! U.S.: Hands Off Rasmea Odeh!
8. Defeat imperialism. Shut down the Pentagon. U.S. hands off Latin America, the Caribbean, Asia, Africa and the Middle East. Build international solidarity! VIVA CUBA! U.S.: Hands Off Venezuela! Venceremos!
9. Full employment and decent jobs or income for all regardless of race, religion, age, gender, disability or arrest history. End all forms of austerity worldwide. Support the movement for \$15 and a union. Abolish "right to work" (for less) laws. Repeal Taft Hartley. Stop killing disabled people, especially those with emotional disabilities. Overturn Act 10! Union YES Jim Crow NO! Support the Stone Creek Coffee Workers!
10. End the prison-industrial complex and mass incarcerations of Black and Brown youth. Abolish solitary confinement and the death penalty. Free Mumia Abu-Jamal, Ana Belen Montes, Leonard Peltier, the MOVE prisoners, Mulutu Shakur, Aafia Siddiqui and all political prisoners. Stop FBI harassment of activists.

# **WISCONSIN BAIL OUT THE PEOPLE MOVEMENT**

## **organizes to demand union jobs, public ed., housing & healthcare .... while fighting against the filthy bankers, racist police terror, sexism & LGBTQ oppression**

The Wisconsin Bail Out The People Movement is an outgrowth of the Bailout the People Movement (BOPM), a national network that was founded in October 2008 to oppose the trillion dollar bank bail out and to demand that the people get bailed out instead. BOPM held the protest against joblessness calling for a "Real Jobs Program" at the G20 summit in Pittsburgh.

WI BOPM formed in June 2011 and the first protest of our organization was at Chase Bank in downtown Milwaukee to protest the mass foreclosures in the city. WI BOPM is a completely independent organization funded entirely by poor and working people's hard earned funds.

Since then WI BOPM has taken up the most crucial issues facing workers, students and ordinary people including jobs; foreclosures and evictions; education and student rights; immigrant and worker's rights; stopping racism and hate groups like the Tea Party; opposing the ongoing wars that are bleeding the economy dry; fighting to stop billions of dollars being given to the banks for 'debt service';; advocating for health care for all; demanding reproductive freedom and justice for women and rights for LGBTQ people and much, much more.

We are fighting for a national Public Works Jobs Program similar to the Works Progress Administration (WPA) enacted during the Great Depression; for a moratorium on home foreclosures; to stop evictions and utility shut-offs; to have the Employee Free Choice Act implemented; and to have full rights for migrant/immigrant workers and refugees among other struggles.

We oppose any and all attacks on poor and working people and daily are in the streets and workplaces across Wisconsin building the people's struggle. We oppose the \$900 million hate machine the Bradley Foundation and similar right-wing "think tanks" such as the so-called Americans For Prosperity and the Wisconsin Institute for Law and Liberty, all enemies of the people.

WI BOPM members fight union-busting and other attacks against poor and working people. We support union contract campaigns and struggles including supporting in 2015 the UAW Local 833 and ATU Local 998 strikes. We are steadfast supporters of public education and thus support unions like the MTEA. We have slept on the marble floors of the people's capitol in the winter and spring of 2011 with our sisters and brothers and have participated in a rainbow of mass demonstrations in Madison, Milwaukee and other cities in Wisconsin. We helped kick the Nazi's out of West Allis in September 2011 and the fascists out of Madison in January 2019 and have joined many public education and immigrant rights actions, helped to fight for justice for Dontre Hamilton and others murdered by the police and much more.

Since June 2011 when our WI BOPM blog and Facebook page became LIVE, we've helped to promote thousands of people's events in Wisconsin and internationally to build a fighting people's movement! We really believe in UNITY & SOLIDARITY!
